Introduction/How to Access Report

1.1 Overview

The KeyNavigator Certificates of Deposit (CD) Report is designed to provide you with Account Details and Transaction History, when and how you need them.

2.1 Navigating to Report

To access the Certificates of Deposit Report:

- 1. Log on to KeyNavigator using your credentials.
- 2. From the main navigation bar, hover over the **Reporting & Research** tab.
- 3. In the drop-down menu, click on Certificates of Deposit.
- 4. Open and closed accounts will now appear.


Note: If you do not see Certificates of Deposit under the Reporting & Research tab, contact your company administrator or your KeyBank Relationship team to request access.



2.2 Navigating to View All Accounts

Once you have selected Certificates of Deposit, you can now access the Certificates of Deposit Accounts. Here, you will see a snapshot view of the:


- Account Name
- Account Number
- Balance

2.3 Navigating to Account Detail and Transaction History

When viewing the list of all accounts, selecting the Account Name tile will open both the Account Detail and Transaction History underneath for that account. To find out more about what this report entails, navigate to the Features section of the user guide.




2.4 Navigating to Export

To export a CSV file of the Certificates of Deposit Report, you will:

- 1. Select Account Name for the Report you want to Export
- 3. Find and select the **Export** button

2. Navigate to the Transaction History details

4. A CSV file will download



Features

3.1 Account Names

The Account Names section of the Certificates of Deposit Report will include a snapshot of details for your Accounts, including:

Account Name


This is the name assigned to the Certificate of Deposit account. It typically reflects the business unit, purpose, or internal naming convention used by your organization.

Account Number

The Account Number is the unique identifier assigned to each CD. This number is used for tracking and reference purposes across KeyBank systems.

Balance

This field displays the current balance of the CD. If the account has matured and been closed, the balance will show as \$0.00 and the status will indicate (Closed).



Features

3.2 Account Detail

The Account Detail section of the report will show you the details for your Certificate of Deposit Account, including:

Account Title

The name of the account set up during account opening.

Balance

The current total value of the CD.

Available Balance

The amount currently available for withdrawal. Note: Penalties will occur if withdrawal occurs before Maturity Date.

Last Interest Payment

The most recent interest amount credited to the account, including the payment date.

Total Interest Paid YTD

The total interest credited to the account year to date.

Total Interest Paid Last Year

The total interest credited during the previous calendar year.


Interest Rate

The annual percentage yield (APY) applied to the CD.

The duration of the CD (e.g., six months, one year).

Maturity Date

The date on which the CD will mature and be eligible for withdrawal or renewal.



Features

3.3 Transaction History

The Transaction History section of the report will show you all the transactions that have occurred through the lifespan of the Certificate of Deposit. These details will include:

Transaction Date

The date the transaction was posted.

Transaction Description

A brief description of the transaction (e.g., "INTEREST CREDITED," "OPENING DEPOSIT").

Transaction Amount

The amount of the transaction. Positive values indicate credits to the account.

Account Running Balance

The account balance after the transaction was applied.
